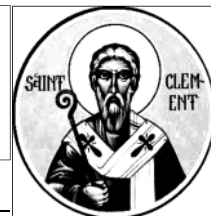

From the Catechism...

42. In what way does God reveal that he is love?

God revealed himself to Israel as the One who has a stronger love than that of parents for their children or of husbands and wives for their spouses. God in himself "is love" (1 John 4: 8.16), who gives himself completely and gratuitously, who "so loved the world that he gave his only Son so that the world might be saved through him" (John 3:16-17). By sending his Son and the Holy Spirit, God reveals that he himself is an eternal exchange of love.

Important Information regarding the proposed new Shared Campus Primary School in our parish.

Dundee City Council has issued proposals for the replacement of Charleston Primary School, Lochee Primary School and St. Clement's Primary School with a shared site school on the site of the present St. Clement's School.

Mgr. Ken McCaffrey, the Catholic Church Representative on the Education Committee has stated that the Diocese of Dunkeld supports these proposals and, if agreed, will continue to work with the Council on the proposal and the building of the new school.

Under the "Education [Public and Consultations etc] (Scotland) Regulations 1981", it is necessary to consult all interested parties on this matter.

A Public Consultation Meeting will take place in St. Clement's Primary School on Tuesday 10th March at 7.00 p.m., to which all parents and carers of children at the school, or those due to attend the school in the future are invited to attend.

Feast of St. John Ogilvie: Tuesday of this week is the feast of priest and martyr, St. John Ogilvie. He was the born into of a wealthy Calvinist family in Keith. After being received into the Catholic Church, he joined the Society of Jesus or Jesuits. After several years in Europe he returned to Scotland to look after the remaining Catholics of Glasgow. He was arrested and found guilty of high treason. As he was led to the gallows his last words were: "If there be here any hidden Catholics, let them pray for me but the prayers of heretics I will not have." He was hung at Glasgow Cross on 10 March 1615, at the age of 36. He was canonised by Pope Paul VI in 1976
